WHILE Russian art from the 18th and 19th centuries is highly acclaimed, few people know about the present scene in that country.

The **Russian Collection**—a unique exhibition-cum-sale of art works by leading contemporary Russian artists—provides a chance to update your

knowledge. Presented by The Oberoi, New Delhi and Bank of America, The collection includes oils, watercolours, tapestries, batik, etchings and ceramics by 17 artists. At present, 12 of them are visiting India courtesy of the Roerich International Memorial Trust and the Indo-Russian Roerich Club. Proceeds from sales will go towards the restoration of the Roerich estate in Kulu. The collection will be on show at New Delhi's Habiart Gallery, Lodhi Road, until December 20, 1992, from 11 am to 7 pm (except Mondays).
